

4th Grade Flipgrid Instructions

We will be using Flipgrid as an option for students to demonstrate their skills on their book songs and on orchestra music. They can also share their own musical creations here too! All of this PLUS they will receive feedback from the teacher as well!

Flipgrid can be accessed by computer through their website, www.flipgrid.com, or by using the Flipgrid app that is available for mobile devices. Here is all the information they need to get started. It is also located on your child's classlink dashboard.

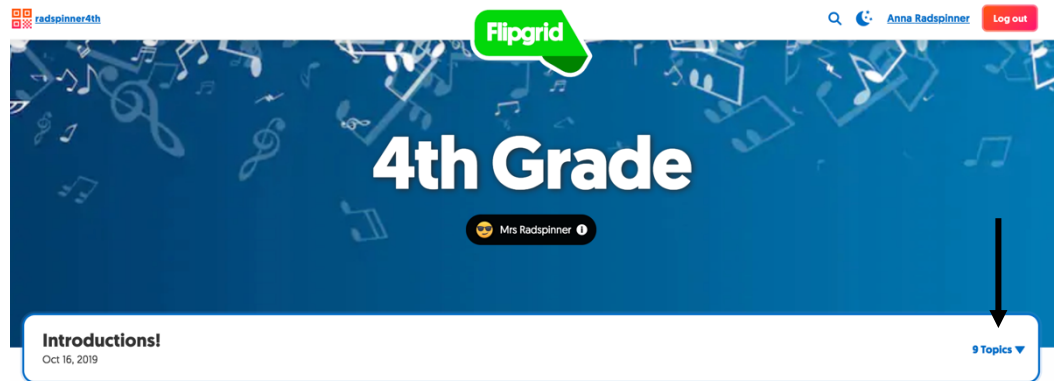

Choose the Microsoft Login option: Your school email (it should look like this...28radann@wasd.org)

Password is your lunch code.

1- Once in Flipgrid locate TOPICS. Students should post video responses to each topic. I am the only one who can see them. If the video is a great example, I may ask to share the video with the class.



2- I can then send a video or written response called FEEDBACK. Your child can see this feedback by clicking on their name and then clicking on MY FLIPGRID. I will also email feedback. Please check your spam folder!

3- It is at this page your child can see their videos and my feedback.
